Participants

The Lake Geneva School of Cooking requires a **minimum of ten participants (Saturday requires 15)** for a private, holiday party.

Private Facility Fee

For your Holiday Team Building, we will be waiving the \$400 Private Facility Fee on weeknights, Monday-Thursday from Monday, November 27th – Thursday, December 21st. With this offer, we would like to thank all of our past holiday guests and welcome new guests to come.

Cost

Cost *per participant* is \$90. Prices include the hands-on class (about three to four hours long), coaching by Chef John and our staff, sparkling wine and Parmigiano popovers, a tasting wine and a delicious four-course meal. Added costs include supplemental wine, a sales tax of 5.5 percent and a service charge of 20 percent. In addition to this Standard Package, we also offer a Deluxe Package for \$125 *per person*. The Deluxe Package includes all items in the Standard Package, plus a gift bag with a Lake Geneva School of Cooking apron, class recipes and assorted kitchen utensils.

Payment Policy
